

The C major chord





The above pattern uses all the 4 fingers. In the above pattern, a 5th note is played on the 6th string. Below, the 6th string is left open to play a Major 3rd note.




The A minor chord




The G major chord






In the above pattern, 5th note I splayed on the 2nd string. IN the pattern below, the 2nd string is left open to play the Major 3rd note of the chord.

G major chord






The F major chord
